



Modern Slavery Statement

This voluntary disclosure has been published in accordance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015 for the financial year ending 31st December 2017. Beeswax Dyson Farming Limited (BDFL) is part of the Weybourne Group Limited group of companies.

The majority of suppliers are UK-based and BDFL does not trade with any of the countries currently defined as 'high' or 'extreme risk' according to the Modern Slavery Index. BDFL operates within the UK in the areas of farming, property and energy production.

BDFL is committed to acting in an ethical manner and to ensuring that modern slavery plays no part in the operations of our business or that of our suppliers. A code of conduct is supplied to all BDFL suppliers and contractors and it is made clear that BDFL reserves the right to commission an audit of their business activities and/or terminate any agreements should this code be breached.

A number of company policies and procedures exist to ensure the fair treatment of those employed directly and indirectly by BDFL. These include documented 'right to work' checks, a whistleblowing policy and an equal opportunities policy. Any activities investigated under these policies and the resulting decision will be reported to the Board of Directors at each quarterly meeting.
